

CAMPGROUND PET POLICY

Willow Lake requires **all campers bringing pets** into Willow Lake Campground to read and sign this policy before occupying a campsite. Per industry standard and concern for our campers' safety, certain dog breeds are prohibited at Willow Lake Campground unless they are certified, with proper paperwork, as a Service Animal / Psychiatric Service Dog (PSD) / Emotional Support Animal (ESA) / Therapy Animal.

1. No More than **2 pets** per site are permitted.
2. Visitors of guests are **not permitted** to bring pets into the campground.
3. All pets should have proper **vaccination documentation** to be presented and filed at the office.
4. Pets should **never** be left unattended, including inside your RV.
5. Pets must be on a short leash (6' or less) when being walked or on a strong durable rope or chain that will not allow the pet to extend off your campsite in any direction. Children under 10 are not allowed to walk pets unsupervised in the campground.
6. Pets creating a disturbance or being a nuisance **will not be tolerated**.
7. All pet droppings are the responsibility of the pet owner and should be cleaned up promptly.
8. Pets are not allowed in public buildings unless a service dog

Restricted Breeds:

Akita / American Bulldog / American Stafford Terrier / Canary Dog (Presa Canario) / Chow / Doberman / German Shepherd or Shepherd Mix / Louisiana Catahoula Leopard Dog / Mastiff or Mastiff Mixes / Pit Bull or Pit Bull Mixes / St. Francis Terrier / Staffordshire Bull Terrier / Tosa Inu / Wolf or Wolf Hybrids

Service Dogs must be registered with the National Service Animal Registry. For a person to have a qualified service dog he/she must have a disability that substantially limits his/her ability to perform at least one major life task without assistance.

Psychiatric Service Dogs (PSD) must be prescribed for a person by a licensed mental health professional in a properly formatted letter that states a PSD is needed to perform tasks that a person is unable to perform for him/herself during certain events.

Emotional Support Animals (ESA) must be prescribed by a licensed therapist in a properly formatted letter that states the person is determined to be emotionally or psychologically disabled and that the presence of the animal necessary for the disabled persons mental health.

Therapy animals are more commonly taken to visit patients in hospitals, nursing homes, and rehabilitation facilities to support mental health or physical therapy. Therapy animals must be registered.

I have read the above rules regarding pets and agree to abide by them. Willow lake campground has the right to refuse or require that campers remove any pet that may threaten the safety of our campers.

- I certify that my pet **has never been** involved in a dog/person or in a dog/dog incident.
- I have provided a recent set of vaccine documents for my pet.
